1. Organisation overview

Thames Gateway EdEquity CIC, Company No. 16942795, was incorporated in December 2025. Registered office: 18 Nicholas Close, South Ockendon, RM15 6NJ.

We deliver free tutoring, mentoring, careers guidance and digital skills support to young people aged 11 to 17 across Thurrock, Havering and Barking and Dagenham. The CIC is asset-locked to IntoUniversity.

We are members of Thurrock CVS, the National Digital Inclusion Network and Charity Excellence, and benchmark financial practice against Good Finance frameworks.

2. Logic model

Inputs: trained volunteer mentors and tutors, community venues, an eligibility and needs scorecard, and validated outcome instruments.

Activities: one-to-one mentoring, academic confidence and study-skills sessions, and community referral and outreach.

Outputs: enrolment, sessions delivered and meaningful-dose completion.

Outcomes: wellbeing change using WEMWBS, behavioural and emotional development using SDQ, and academic-readiness confidence change.

3. Governance and safeguarding

The directors are Kehinde Oyelowo Akingbehin, Kehinde Adeola Adebambo and Olukunle Ade-Alade. Kehinde Adeola Adebambo is the Designated Safeguarding Lead.

Volunteers working directly with young people require enhanced DBS checks. A two-adult rule applies to direct delivery. Written parental or guardian consent is obtained before assessment or sessions for participants under 16. Risk-of-harm concerns are escalated immediately.

4. Outcomes data

No completed-cohort results are currently claimed. WEMWBS, SDQ and readiness results will be published with completion rates once the first cohort completes and data has been checked.

5. Management accounts summary

Management accounts for 27 May to 11 June 2026 recorded a closing balance of GBP 1,405.00. This reflects an early-stage, volunteer-led organisation that had not yet received a major delivery grant.

6. Current funders and partners
